

CAMP KERR LAKE GENERAL INFORMATION

Welcome to Camp Kerr Lake. We are a non-denominational Christian Camp seeking to strengthen and encourage families through Biblical foundations. We are open to the public, but require all our guests to abide by our Camp Kerr Lake Community Covenants and to conduct themselves in a manner consistent with our ministry's Statement of Faith.

It is our policy not to permit overnight lodging by any unmarried couples in the same RV, tent, or cabin, as it is clearly inconsistent with scriptural principles regarding the sanctity of marriage in God's Word, the Bible, and our ministry's Statement of Faith. It is also our policy not to permit the use of any of our facilities to those who choose not to abide by our Camp Kerr Lake Community Covenants.

It is our goal to provide you, our guests, with a clean, safe, peaceful, and spiritually encouraging camping environment. Christian hospitality and grace is our standard at Camp Kerr Lake. Please make a special effort to be considerate of those that are sharing this beautiful place with you during your stay. The following information is provided to help you plan your valuable vacation time, and to allow us to respond as effectively as possible in meeting your needs.

We are open April through November.

Reservations

We are a reservation-only operation, with a 2-night minimum, and do not accept drop-ins. Beginning **January 1st** reservations will be accepted by mail or through our website campkerrlake.org. If the site(s) requested is/are not available, a second or third choice site will be reserved if available. Cash or personal checks are always welcome, or you can pay your deposit and your balances securely online through our website and our business partnership with PayPal.

The following additional restrictions apply:

- **Minimum of two nights stay** for all reservations
- **Memorial Day weekend** and **Labor Day weekend** require a minimum 3-night stay.
- **Fourth of July week** requires a minimum 7-night stay.
- **Maximum stay is 14 days**

Deposit

A **\$60.00** deposit is required for **each date and site** you wish to reserve **with the exception** of Memorial Day Weekend and Labor Day Weekend where there is a three night minimum and all three nights must be paid for at the time of reservation. Information on when to pay deposits will be provided in your confirmation letter.

Confirmation

A confirmation of your reservation will be mailed, emailed or made by phone as soon as your application has been processed. Directions on deposit/payment amounts and due dates will be included in this letter.

Full Payments

In order to guarantee your site, **full payment (less deposit) is due two weeks prior to arrival at Camp**. A payment reminder will accompany your confirmation letter, email, or phone call.

Cancellations and Refunds

Full payments will be refunded if you cancel your reservation more than two (2) weeks before the initial date reserved. For cancellations after that date, we will make every effort to rent your site or facility for the period you reserved and will refund that portion of fees paid only if rented. Cancellations and requests for refunds may be made to the Camp Registrar by any of the means provided above. **Refunds are not issued for rain.**

Daily Program Fees

Group Tent Sites	\$10.00 per tent per night
A-Frame Cabins	\$30.00 per night (8 person maximum - two night minimum)
Counselors' Cabin	\$40.00 per night (5 person maximum – two night minimum)
Day Use/Visitors	\$2.00 per person per day

Boat Launching	\$5.00 per boat per day (non-campers)
Canoe/Kayak Rental	\$5.00 for up to 2 hours; \$15.00 for full day
Paddleboard Rental	\$15.00 for up to 2 hours; \$40.00 for full day
RV Storage	\$10.00 per week or any portion of a week
Ice Bags	\$ 2.00 per bag
Day Use	\$ 2.00 per person per day (non-campers)
Gas Grill	\$10.00 per day per grill

R.V. Storage

Recreational Vehicles (i.e. motor homes, travel trailers, pop-up campers, etc. and/or trailered boats and boat trailers) may be stored on the camp grounds (in the area designated) provided the equipment is to be used in relation to a fee paying, camp visit within the next 4 weeks. The minimum storage fee charge is for one week and is charged for any partial week. Storage of any RV('s) **must not** be initiated until a "**Liability Release Form**" has been executed by the owner and witnessed by the Camp Manager.

Check-in & Check-out

Check-in is at 4:00 PM. Early check-in after 12:00 noon is permitted if the site is not occupied. Check-in **prior to** noon is permitted if site is not occupied for an **additional fee of \$10.00**. **Check-out is at 2:00 PM.** Late check-out until 6:00 PM is permitted if the site is available and **only with the prior permission of the camp manager.**

Liability Disclaimer

Individuals, families and/or groups engaging in any recreational activities on the property do so **at their own risk**. This includes all swimming and/or other water activities conducted in and/or on Kerr Lake Reservoir. **No lifeguards are provided.** Children must be supervised by adults, and adults must not swim alone.

A Resident Manager or Camp Host is at the camp full-time during the camping season when campers are onsite. The resident manager is responsible for supervising and maintaining the camp facilities, checking guests in and out, and overseeing programs and services provided by the camp.

Accommodations:

RV Hook-Up Sites: There are 27 sites, equipped with electrical and water connections overlooking the lake. There are two bathhouses with hot showers and a large, grassy recreation field that can be used for play and sport activities.

A-Frame Cabins: Each of our 6 rustic cabins have eight stackable bunks with mattresses (8 people maximum) in a secluded wooded area. There is a picnic shelter with 8 picnic tables and a commercial gas grill centrally located to the cabins, and a private swim area located down a short path to the waterfront. The bathhouse is located only a short walking distance away via a path through the woods.

Counselors' Cabin: The Counselors' Cabin is air-conditioned, will sleep 5, and is located in the A-Frame Cabin area. There is a covered picnic table, gas grill and a fire pit adjacent to the cabin.

Osprey/Eagle Lodges: These facilities are available for rent on a "not-to-interfere" basis with our Youth Camps. The air-conditioned/heated Osprey Lodge is located in the Recreation Area near the Welcome Center, Bath House, and Pavilion, and can sleep 16 (stackable bunkbeds) in 4 separate bedrooms adjoining a casual, central meeting room with mini-fridge, microwave and coffee maker. A small, covered metal picnic shelter with 4 picnic tables is adjacent to the Lodge. The air-conditioned/heated Eagle Lodge is located in the RV Area near the Bath House, and can sleep 16 (stackable bunkbeds) in 4 separate bedrooms adjoining a casual, central meeting room with mini-fridge, microwave and coffee maker. There are no cooking or bathroom facilities in either of the Lodges, and linens are not provided.
